Digital Learning Days Parent Information

OVERVIEW

For pre-planned professional learning days or short-term emergency school closures, instruction will continue as *asynchronous* DLD: Red Level 1. Students will have the opportunity to continue their learning online from home through Canvas. Teachers will be available for virtual "office hours" through Canvas if students or parents have questions on the material or need assistance with digital learning.

At times, teachers may be scheduled into fullday professional development meetings and unavailable for office hours. In that case, staff will provide parents and students with a point of contact for immediate support and respond to emails or Canvas messages within 24-hours.

DAILY ASSIGNMENT EXPECTATIONS

Kindergarten – 5th Grade

One assignment in each of the following: Math, ELA with Science & Social Studies integrated, and specials (see schedule).

* Students in the gifted program (Venture) will be served on their scheduled day.

<u>6th – 8th Grade</u> One assignment from each of a student's classes

<u>9th – 12th Grade</u> One assignment from each of a student's classes



TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Make sure your student can access Canvas.
- Set up your parent account.
- Combined work from all classes totals 2-3 hours for elementary students and 4-5 hours for middle and high school students per day.

VIRTUAL OFFICE HOURS

Check with your children's teacher for details on how to connect with them through Canvas on the Digital Learning Day.

As a minimum, teacher office hours are as follows:

- Elementary: 9-10am OR 1-2pm
- Middle/High: 10-11am OR 2-3pm

REQUIREMENTS

- All Digital Work will be housed in Canvas in a module labeled "DATE Digital Learning Day".
- The module will be published for student access by 9:00 am on the Digital Learning Day.
- Each subject's work will have a submission component such as quiz, discussion, or assignment.

RED LEVEL

DIGITAL ACCESS CONCERNS

- Students may request a hard copy of assignments upon return to school.
- Students will have time upon returning to school to complete assignments.
- Media Centers will be open before and after school as needed following a closure to provide students access to computers.

SPECIALS SCHEDULE

Elementary homeroom teachers will communicate the specials assignments students should complete each day.
