

Transportation Procedure for Homeless Students to School of Origin

To arrange transportation for homeless students to a school of origin:

 Have parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth, complete the Student Residency Statement form, JBC(1)E(3) and fax to the Homeless Education Liaison at 770-443-6014

Note – If "none of the above" is marked on the Student Residency Statement form, the student does not qualify as homeless under the federal definition of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Act and is not eligible to receive transportation to the school of origin.

 Parent/Guardian or unaccompanied youth should complete the Enrollment in School of Origin Request Form for Homeless Students JBC(1)E(1). When the form is completed, fax to the Homeless Education Liaison at 770-443-6014 to determine feasibility.

Feasible: The law states that to the extent feasible, homeless students are to be kept in their school of origin unless doing so is contrary to the wishes of the parent/guardian. In determining feasibility, the district must make school placement determinations based on the "best interest" of the homeless student.
