This Week's Focus

Math: 2D Shapes and 3D Shapes

ELA: Reading books about wants and needs and Holiday books

Letter of the Week: Zz

Writing: The students are working on drawing to show meaning. They are also learning to separate words by leaving a space when writing a sentence, that a sentence is a group of words and to put a period at the end of their sentence.
