## PCs for People

A nonprofit organization that provides low-cost computers and free or affordable internet connection for low-income households.

- Potential recipients must be living below the 200% poverty level and currently enrolled in a government assistance program.
- PC for people offers high-speed internet for only \$11.25 per month with no credit check or hidden fees.
- You will also be eligible to receive affordable PC or laptop repair for as low \$25.
- For purchases in store or online, you must have...
  - Photo ID
  - Eligibility document dated within the last six months (unless it is an annual document)

## Spectrum

**Spectrum Internet Assist** – provides affordable high-speed internet connection to low-income families, students and seniors for just \$14.99 per month.

- Free Internet modem
- High-speed Internet at 30 Mbps
- No data caps & No contracts
- Optional in-home WiFi service at \$5/mo
- One or more members of your household must be a recipient of one of the following assistance programs:
  - National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
  - Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the NSLP
  - Supplemental Security Income (for applicants age 65+ only)

## Comcast

**Comcast** is offering an internet essentials package FREE for 60 days. Click [here](#) for more information.

### **Comcast Internet Essentials:**

- Anyone who signs up for Internet Essentials will receive two free months of Internet service. We are also increasing the speed of the program to 25 Mbps downloads, and 3 Mbps uploads for all new and existing customers.
- After first two free months expire, you can either cancel the service (which you can do at any time) or keep it as a regular paying Internet Essentials customer. You will receive an easy to use self-install-kit that includes a cable modem (to receive service at your home) with a WiFi router (to connect your devices without wires). There is no term contract or credit check and no shipping fee for equipment. **Call:** No direct number for this program; must log in to enter a phone number and receive a call from an agent
