



Transportation Procedures for School of Origin Request

1. The parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth should first complete the Student Residency Statement JBC(1)E(3), and School of Origin request form JBC(1)E(1), and return to the Homeless Education Liaison. Once approved for services under the McKinney-Vento ACT, transportation to the school of origin may be requested (see item two).
2. Parent/Guardian or unaccompanied youth should complete the Transportation Request form and return to the Homeless Education Liaison. Once the request is reviewed, a best interest determination will be made, and the parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth will be contacted.

Feasible: The law states that to the extent feasible, homeless students are to be kept in their school of origin. In determining feasibility, the district must make school placement determinations based on the best interest of the homeless student.
