NPHS Daily Parking Rules & Guidelines 2024-2025

In consideration for the privilege of driving and parking a motor vehicle on the campus of North Paulding High School, the student and parent hereby acknowledge and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Paulding County School District stated in the Parking Permit Application and Vehicle Registration form and the rules and regulations of North Paulding High School stated below.

1. All students desiring to drive a vehicle to school to lease a daily parking permit must submit a valid insurance card, registration, and driver's license upon application via the method and format requested by the school.
2. Daily parking is \$5 per day and individual students may only purchase 2 days of parking within a 5-day period. Payment is via RevTrak in the front office only.
3. The daily parking permit must be displayed appropriately. This means the number and pass can easily be observed from outside of the vehicle by being placed on the dash.
4. The driver/owner of any vehicle will be responsible for the use of the vehicle while on campus and subsequently for any violation of any rules or regulations (shown below).
5. Vehicle owners agree to maintain adequate liability insurance and current registration.
6. Paulding County Board of Education shall not be responsible for any losses or damage to the property of users of its facilities, including loss due to bodily injury.
7. A student parking on campus whose vehicle does not have a valid parking permit risks having the vehicle towed away at the owner's expense.
 - a. Cars will be towed by Moore's Towing (770/443-0692); all fees will be paid directly to this company.
8. Revocation of parking privileges may range from at least one week to the rest of the school year. Serious offenses could result in permanent revocation. The length of revocation shall be at the discretion of the principal or his or her designee.
9. Students whose parking privileges have been revoked into the subsequent semester or school year will be eligible to purchase daily parking or a parking permit and regain the privilege of driving and parking on campus at the conclusion of the period of revocation IF daily/student parking spaces are available at that time.
10. Students whose parking privileges have been suspended or revoked will not be allowed to use daily/emergency parking.
11. Refunds will not be issued to students who have had their parking privileges suspended or revoked.
12. Vehicles are not permitted to display any flag, banner, sticker, decal or message, which may be determined by school officials as being offensive or deemed disruptive to the safe and orderly operation of the school. This rule applies while the vehicle is being driven onto or off campus or while parked on campus. It also applies if the vehicle is being used to represent the school on an off-campus activity.
13. Students are responsible for any contraband in their vehicle. All vehicles parked on campus are subject to search.

*****Any student driver who leaves school property OR takes another student off campus without permission will immediately lose all parking privileges for the remainder of the semester and be denied those privileges permanently.***
