Operation and Organizational Excellence

FY2026 Budget Update—Amber Thesma presented the FY2026 Budget Primer, outlining the budget timeline and key factors influencing the budget, including demographic and economic trends, enrollment projections, and funding. Today's meeting marked the first of two required public meetings, with the second scheduled for April 1, 2025.
